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Chapter 1 SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

All operators and service personnel must read and understand this manual before operating or servicing equipment.

All maintenance and service on this equipment must be performed by trained technicians.

Electrical



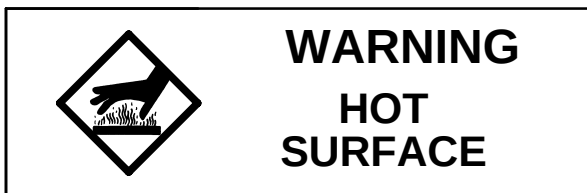
Dangerous voltages exist at several points in this equipment. To avoid personal injury, do not touch exposed connections and components while input

power is on. Disconnect, lockout and tag external electrical power before removing protective panels.

A secure connection to a reliable earth ground is essential for safe operation.

A disconnect switch with lockout capability must be provided in the line ahead of the unit. Wiring used to supply electrical power should be installed by a qualified electrician.

High Temperatures



Severe burns can occur if unprotected skin comes in contact with molten adhesive or hot application system parts.

Safety glasses, gloves and long-sleeved clothing must be worn whenever working with or around adhesive application systems.

High Pressure



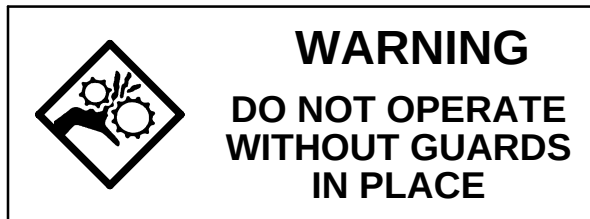
To avoid personal injury, do not operate the equipment without all covers, panels and safety guards properly installed.

To prevent serious injury from molten adhesive under pressure when servicing the equipment, disengage the pumps and relieve the adhesive system's hydraulic pressure (e.g., trigger the heads, hand-held applicators, and/or other application devices into a waste container) before opening any hydraulic fittings or connections.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Even when a system's pressure gauge reads "0" psig, residual pressure and trapped air can remain within it causing hot adhesive and pressure to escape without warning when a filter cap or a hose or hydraulic connection is loosened or removed. For this reason, always wear eye protection and protective clothing.

Either of the two High Pressure symbols shown may be used on ITW Dynatec equipment.

Protective Covers



Keep all guards in place!

To avoid personal injury, do not operate the application system without all covers, panels and safety guards properly installed.

Eye Protection & Protective Clothing



Wear safety glasses with side shields which conform to ANSI Z87.1 or EN166.

Failure to wear safety glasses could result in severe eye injury.

It is important to protect yourself from potential burns when working around hot melt adhesive equipment.

Wear protective gloves and long-sleeved, protective clothing to prevent burns that could result from contact with hot material or hot components.

Always wear steel-reinforced safety shoes.

It is very important that you PROTECT YOUR EYES when working around hot melt adhesive equipment!

Safe Installation and Operation

To avoid possible failure of hoses, make sure all hoses are routed to avoid kinking, tight radius turns (8" or less) and abrasive contact. Hot-melt hoses should not have prolonged contact with heat-absorbing surfaces such as cold floors or metal troughs. These heat-absorbing surfaces can alter adhesive flow and cause incorrect calibration. Hoses should never be covered with materials that prevent heat dissipation, such as insulation or sheathing.

Read this manual before applying electrical power to the equipment. Equipment may be damaged by incorrect electrical connections.

Do not use adhesive that is dirty or that may be chemically contaminated. Doing so can cause system

clogging and pump damage.

When adhesive hand-held applicators or other movable applicators are used, never point them at yourself or at any other person. Never leave a hand-held applicator's trigger unlocked when not actually in use.

Do not operate the hopper or other system components without adhesive for more than 15 minutes if the temperature is 150 degrees C (300 degrees F) or more. To do so will cause charring of the residual adhesive.

Never activate the heads, hand-held applicators and/ or other application devices until the adhesive's temperature is within the operating range. Severe damage could result to internal parts and seals.

Treatment for Burns From Hot Melt Adhesives

Burns caused by hot melt adhesive must be treated at a burn center.

Care should be used when working with hot melt adhesives in the molten state. Because they rapidly

solidify, they present a unique hazard.

Even when first solidified, they are still hot and can cause severe burns. When working near a hot melt application system, always wear safety gloves, safety glasses and long-sleeved, protective clothing.

Always have first-aid information and supplies available.

Call a physician and/or an emergency medical technician immediately.

Service

Refer all servicing to qualified personnel only.

Explosion/ Fire Hazard

Never operate this unit in an explosive environment.

Use cleaning compounds recommended by ITW Dynatec or your adhesive supplier only. Flash points

of cleaning compounds vary according to their composition, so consult with your supplier to determine the maximum heating temperatures and safety precautions.

Lockout/ Tagout

Follow OSHA 1910.147 (Lockout/ Tagout Regulation) for equipment's lockout procedures and other important lockout/ tagout guidelines.

Be familiar with all lockout sources on the equipment.

Even after the equipment has been locked out, there may be stored energy in the application system, particularly in the capacitors within the panel box. To ensure that all stored energy is relieved, wait at least one minute before servicing electrical capacitors.

Use of PUR (Polyurethane) Adhesives

PUR adhesives emit fumes (MDI and TDI) that can be dangerous to anyone exposed to them. These fumes cannot be detected by the sense of smell. ITW Dynatec strongly recommends that an exhaust hood or system be installed over any PUR system.

Consult with your adhesive manufacturer for specifics about required ventilation.



CAUTION: Because of the nature of PUR adhesives to strongly bond in the presence of moisture, care must be taken to prevent them from curing inside Dynatec equipment. If PUR adhesive solidifies in a unit, the unit must be replaced. Always purge old PUR adhesive from the system per your adhesive manufacturer's instructions and time table. ALLOWING PUR ADHESIVE TO CURE IN A UNIT VOIDS ITW DYNATEC'S WARRANTY.

Adhesive Application Solutions

Chapter 2

DESCRIPTION, SPECIFICATIONS AND INSTALLATION

Description

ITW Dynatec's 400/ 480VAC transformer groups step down incoming 400VAC or 480VAC 3-phase delta electrical service so that a Dynamelt S (DMS), C22, N22 or N26 ASU (adhesive supply unit) can operate at 240VAC. This voltage powers the ASU electronics, the AC pump/ motor and drive, and all head and hose temperature zones.

The incoming 400VAC or 480VAC service is routed through a 3-pole, 25A, 480VAC circuit breaker switch and into a transformer set. Incoming power is split off inside the transformer set. 400/480VAC is routed back to the ASU through a fuse block into a DC-controlled solid state relay and is used to power the ASU's hopper elements. 400/480VAC power is also routed to a bank of 1.8KVA transformers. The 240VAC transformer output power is routed through fuse blocks and into the mains connector on the ASU power board.

The Dynatec step-down transformer groups are intended for either 400VAC 3-phase delta connection without neutral or 480VAC 3-phase delta connection without neutral. They should not be used in wash-down environments or in explosive atmospheres.

Transformer Sizing

The step-down transformer groups are available in 2 hose/ head, 4 hose/ head, and 6 hose/ head configurations. Each hose/ head pair is powered by one transformer. Each transformer is sized to deliver a total of 1800W to a pair of two heads and two hoses.

The first transformer provides 1800W to hose and head temperature zones 1 and 2. A second transformer provides 1800W to hose and head zones 3 and 4. If a third transformer is needed, it provides 1800W to hose and head zones 5 and 6.

Example 1:

Hose 1: a #6, 24ft Dynaflex hose	= 672W
Head 1: a single-port BF head	= 220W
Hose 2: a #6, 24ft Dynaflex Hose	= 672W
Head 2: a single-port BF head	= 220W

Total Wattage = 1784W

Since total wattage is less than 1800W, the combination above can be powered with one transformer.

Example 2:

Hose 1: a #6, 24ft Dynaflex hose	= 672W
Head 1: a six-port BF head	= 775W
Hose 2: a #6, 24ft Dynaflex hose	= 672W
Head 2: a six-port BF head	= 775W

Total Wattage = 2894W

Since total wattage exceeds 1800W, the combination above would require two transformers. Each transformer would supply 1447W required to power one hose and one head.

If Total Wattage exceeds 3600W, a third transformer is required.

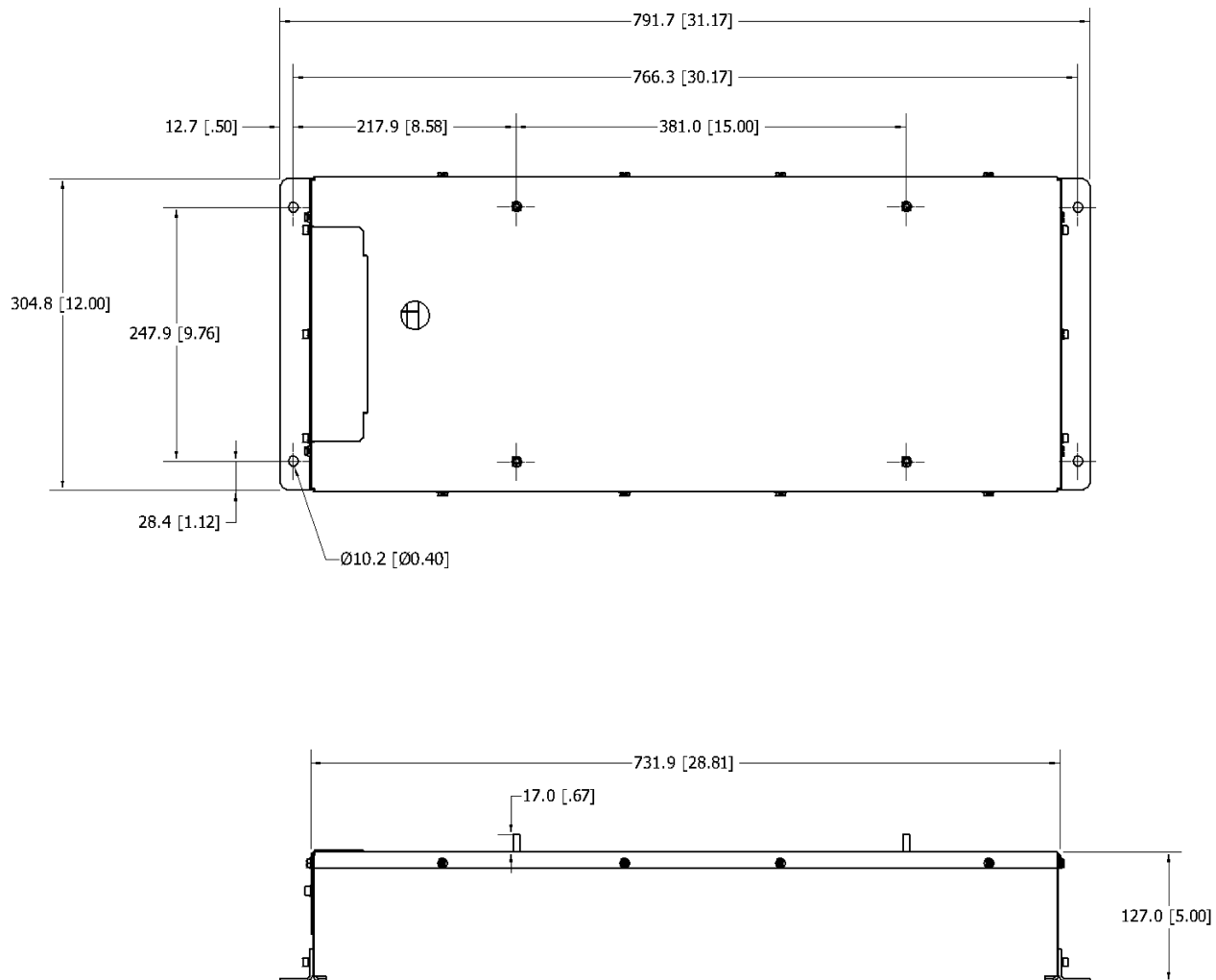

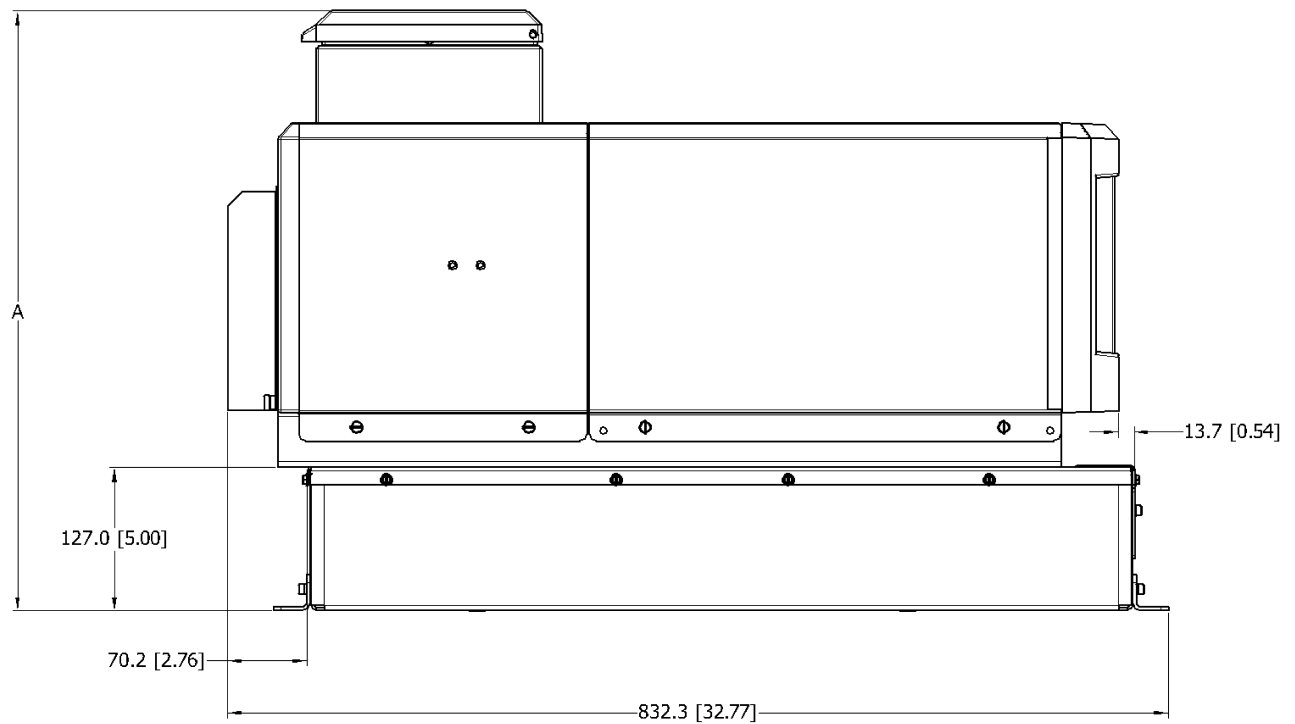

Transformer Case Assembly

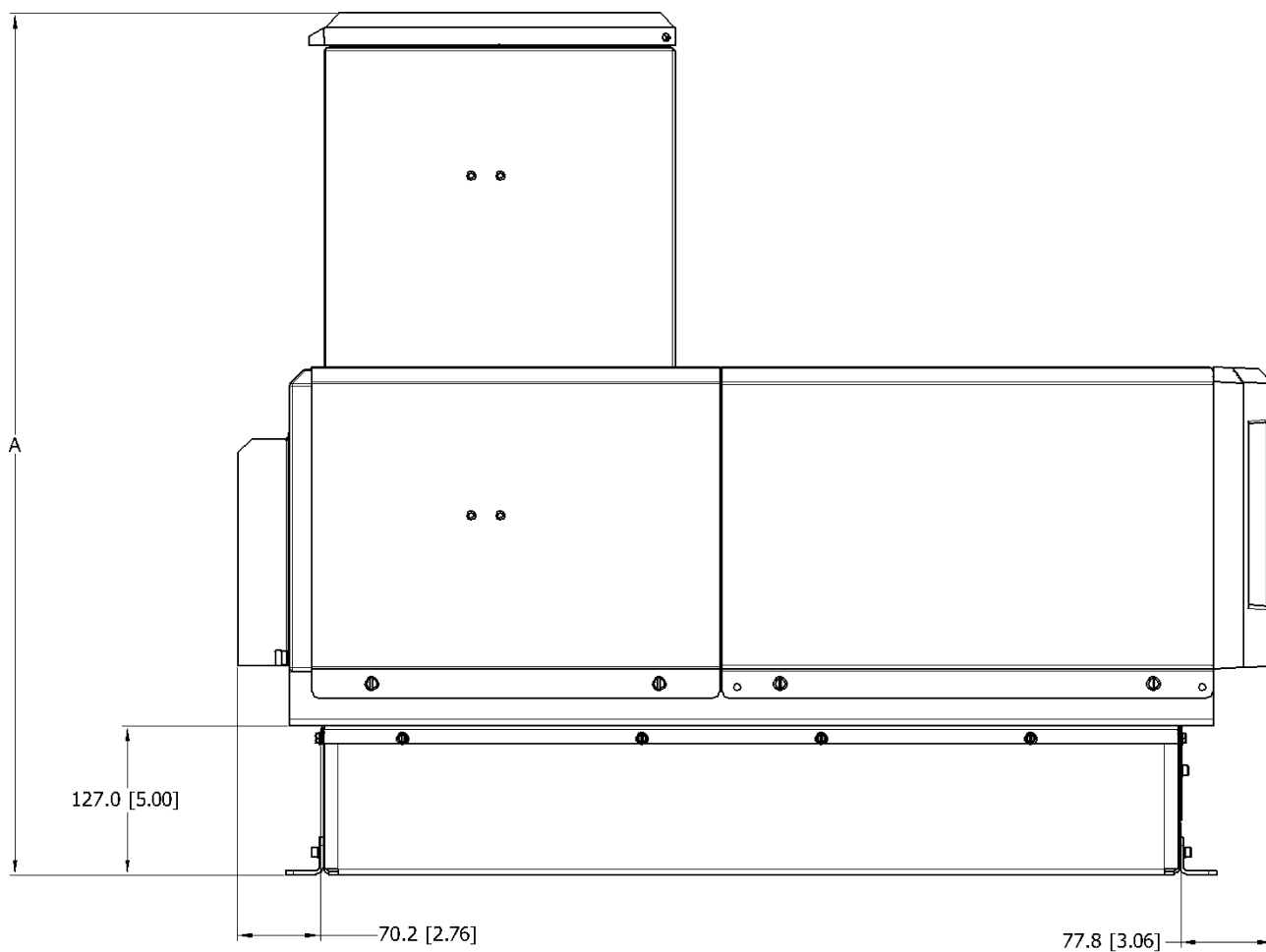

Mounting

Transformer case can be mounted to the ASU by using one of the following methods:

- a. Four 10.2Ø[0.40Ø] holes on end-mounting flanges or
- b. Four 1/4-20 bolts mounted through the frame and transformer case into four 1/4-20 rivet nuts installed into the ASU base rail.

The end-mounting flanges are removable.

Installation

Make sure that the incoming line power to the ASU is disconnected and locked out.

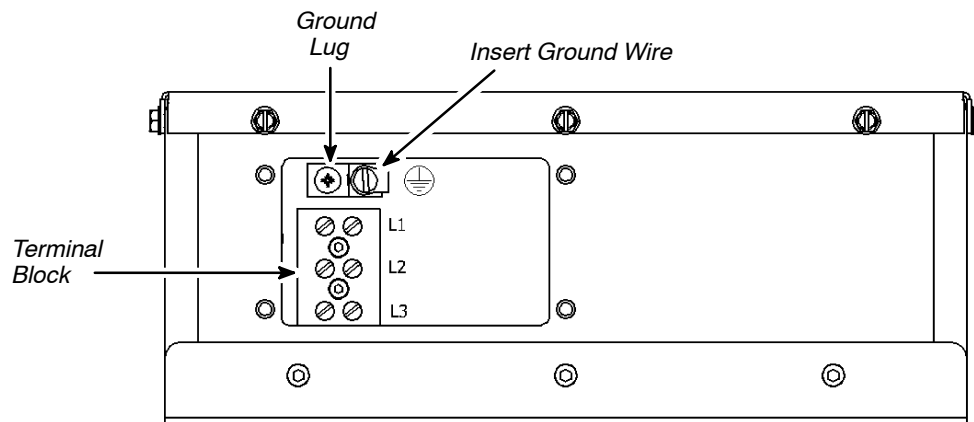
Turn OFF the ASU's main power switch.



DANGER HIGH VOLTAGE

Disconnect and lock out input power to the application system before starting any installation procedures. Make sure there is no electrical power on the leads you will be connecting.

1. Remove the four socket head cap screws and junction box covers located on the back of the transformer enclosure.
2. Run the power cord through the strain relief fitting on the junction box cover.
3. Attach the power cord to the terminal block shown below. Insert ground wire and attach to the ground lug shown below.



4. Tighten the clamp screws on the strain relief fitting.
5. Re-attach the junction box cover.

Chapter 3 SERVICE

Note: Re-read Chapter 1 "Safety Precautions" before performing any service or maintenance procedures. All service or maintenance procedures must be performed by qualified, trained technicians.

Fuse Replacement

Disconnect 400/480VAC circuit breaker. Lockout and tag circuit breaker and plug.

Turn OFF the ASU's main power switch. Verify that power to the ASU is disconnected.



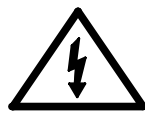
DANGER HIGH VOLTAGE

Disconnect and lock out input power to the application system before starting any installation procedures. Make sure there is no electrical power on the leads you will be connecting.

1. Remove the front fuse access panel.
2. Locate the failed fuse by checking continuity with a multi-meter.
3. Replace fuse.

Transformer Replacement

1. Drain all adhesive from the ASU's hopper.
2. Turn ASU power off and allow unit to cool.
3. Disconnect 400/480VAC circuit breaker. Lockout and tag circuit breaker and plug.
4. Verify that power to the ASU is disconnected.



DANGER HIGH VOLTAGE

Disconnect and lock out input power to the application system before starting any installation procedures. Make sure there is no electrical power on the leads you will be connecting.

5. *Remove transformer case from ASU:*

- a. Remove all 13 thread-forming screws from lid of the case.
- b. Lay the entire ASU on its side.
- c. Remove the bolts attaching the transformer case from the machine's frame.

cont.

6. Separate the lid from the transformer case.

7. *Remove the failed transformer:*

- a. Test transformer(s) to find failure by checking continuity (with a multi-meter) across primary and secondary coils. Refer to schematic in Ch. 4.
- b. Note and record the location of all wiring before removing transformer.
- c. Disconnect and remove wiring to failed transformer.
- d. Install new transformer.
- e. Re-connect wiring and re-assemble case to ASU.
